CALL FOR INTERDISCIPLINARY PROJECTS

I. OBJECT OF THE CALL

The Neuromod Institute opens a call for interdisciplinary projects combining:

(1) Neuroscience-Cognition and (2) Modeling (Mathematics, Computer Science, Physics etc.)

for up to 35 000 euros. Neuromod is mainly willing to help very small projects of a few thousand euros, but the call will also eventually encompass larger projects if the impact for the NeuroMod community is justified.

This sum should typically help to finance:

1. Equipment
2. Functioning resources (typically for experiments)
3. Travel expenses (for coworkers, experimentalists, subjects, volunteers, patients, etc.)
4. Conference registration (but the payment needs to be done in a very short range of time)
5. Actions in Education / Formation, in particular with respect to the pandemic situation

For the 2021 call, **no human resource** (salaries or internships) can be funded.

II. ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA

Any researcher or project team based at Université Côte d'Azur can apply.

The proposal should be approximately one or two pages long (including the project description, the impact for NeuroMod and a precise budget) and must be sent to neuromod.dir@univ-cotedazur.fr. Since the delays are very short, any joint official quotation (“devis”) will be a welcome additional document.

III. SCHEDULE

- Launch: March 23, 2021
- Deadline for sending proposals: **April 19, 2021**

- Selection of the projects and notification to the applicants: May 3, 2021
- For the selected projects, engagement of the funds: June 1, 2021
- Date of delivery (“Date de service fait”): **at most July 31, 2021**

IV. OBLIGATIONS

In case of publications, granted projects must acknowledge the funding source as such:

"This work was supported by the French government through the UCA^{Jedi} project managed by the National Research Agency (ANR-15- IDEX-01) and, in particular, by the interdisciplinary Institute for Modeling in Neuroscience and Cognition (NeuroMod) of the Université Côte d'Azur".

Participation of the project leaders to the life of the NeuroMod Institute will be expected (participation at the yearly conference, for instance, and eventually presentation of scientific results).
