



Excellence scholarships (mobility grants) 1000€ per month for maximum 6 months

I. Eligibility criteria

Students registered in Master 1 of the NeuroMod Institute (Master in Cognitive Sciences or MSc Mod4NeuCog) or PhD students from another institution than Université Côte d'Azur.

There is no age limit or nationality requirement for this grant.

II. Application form

For students admitted in the above-mentioned programs in Master 1:

The candidate must send his/her application file **until December 5th** included, containing following documents:

- CV
- Grades obtained during the last three years
- Opinion of at least two professors from different disciplines
- A motivated interdisciplinary project with local actors
- Copy of passport or identity card
- Any proof of financial difficulties (tax notice, bank statement, certificate of another scholarship on social criteria...).

For PhD students:

The candidate must send his/her application file **until December 5th** included, containing following documents:

- CV
- Grades obtained during the Master
- Motivated interdisciplinary project with local actors, of at least 3 months (fragmentable)
- Motivated opinion of the thesis director
- Letter of recommendation from one local actor
- Copy of passport or identity card
- Any proof of financial difficulties (tax notice, bank statement, certificate of another scholarship on social criteria...).

III. Conditions of attribution

Condition of attribution in both cases:

After deliberation of the Scientific Council of the Institute in January, the scholarship will be set up for each full month that the student spends in France (with a maximum of 6 paid months).

The grant will be awarded based on excellence, integration into the local environment and financial difficulty. Foreign candidates will be favored, even if this does not exclude the financing of French candidates or candidates doing their thesis in France.



The NeuroMod Institute is free to use or not this procedure, according to the means it wishes to spend on the grants and the needs of the master programs.

For students admitted in the above-mentioned Master 1 programs:

The scholarship will be suspended in case of repeated and unjustified absence of the student either in class, or in tutorials, or during internships, or for exams. The scholarship may be withdrawn if the student does not respect the rules of procedure of the university.

For PhD students:

The scholarship will be suspended in case of repeated and unjustified absence of the student in the laboratory in which he/she is supposed to work. The scholarship may be withdrawn in case of non-compliance with the rules of procedure of the university.
