



Master Mobility Grant by the NeuroMod Institute 1000€ per month for maximum 6 months

I. Eligibility criteria

Students enrolled in a Master 2 of the NeuroMod Institute (Master of Cognitive Sciences or MSc Mod4NeuCog) wishing to do an internship abroad.

There is no age limit or nationality requirement to access this grant.

II. Application form

The candidate can send his/her application file whenever needed and at the latest **until December 15th**, including following documents:

- CV
- Grades obtained during the Master 1
- Opinion of at least two professors
- Cover letter presenting the interdisciplinary project carried out abroad
- Letter of recommendation from the person who will supervise the internship (public or private)
- Copy of passport or identity card
- Any proof of financial difficulties (tax notice, bank statement, certificate of another scholarship on social criteria...).

III. Conditions of attribution

After deliberation of the Scientific Council of the Institute, the grant will be set up for a period between 3 to 6 months (1000 euros per month). The grant will be awarded based on excellence, the quality of the project and financial difficulty.

The grant will be suspended in case of repeated and unjustified absence of the student in the structure in which he/she is supposed to work.

The scholarship may be withdrawn in case of non-compliance with the rules of procedure of the host institution/company.

The NeuroMod Institute is free to use or not this procedure, according to the means it wishes to devote on the grants and the needs of the master programs.
